



RULE CHANGES FOR 2026

General Rules, #10

- **A.** Exhibitors are NOT eligible to show after they have graduated from high school (or equivalent for home-schooled youth) regardless of their age or membership status. Any student that has met graduation requirements in December and will not be in school for the second semester leading up to Market Animal Show must be active in a 4-H club **or** be in an approved work-based learning program and active in their FFA chapter to be eligible to show.
- **B.** 4-H members must be actively enrolled in 4-H Online, under Augusta County, prior to completing Fair Entry online nominations for their species. 4-H members must complete a minimum of 6 educational hours and be in good standing with their 4-H Club

General Rules, #25

- To be eligible for the Bred and Owned division in each species, animals must be bred and owned by the exhibitor or immediate family of the exhibitor.

Sheep Rules, #2.

- Lambs must weigh between 90 and 150 pounds and grade Prime or Choice to be eligible for the Show and Sale.

Sale Rules, #5

- Animals will be sold in rotation each year. **The 2026 rotation will be hogs, cattle, sheep, goats.**
